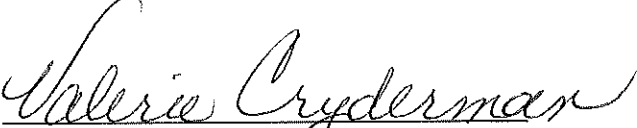
X. Visitor Comments: None
