These scholarships are available to students completing high school in 2013 and planning to enroll full-time for the 2013-2014 school year. Deadline to apply is March 25, 2013.

C.O.O.R. ISD Initiative Scholarship

Applicants must reside in the C.O.O.R. school district. Criteria includes minimum of 3.25 GPA & composite ACT score of 24 or higher to be considered. This scholarship provides full tuition and fees for full-time enrollment fall & winter of 1st academic year and is renewable for a second year.

Gilbert I. Stewart Scholarship

Applicant must have a cumulative of 3.50 GPA. This scholarship is \$1500 for 1st academic year and requires full time enrollment. It is renewable for second year.

President's Scholarship

Applicant must have a cumulative 3.00 GPA. This scholarship is \$1000 for 1st academic year and requires full time enrollment. It is renewable for second year.

Honors Program

The Honors Program provides enhanced educational opportunities for academically talented students by offering challenges and rewards. Federal Financial Aid

Over seven million dollars in federal student aid is awarded annually to Kirtland Community College students. To be considered for grants, student employment or student loans, students must first complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. The FAFSA can be completed online at www.fafsa.gov or call the Federal Student Aid Hotline at 1-800-4FED-AID to have one sent. Complete the 2013-2014 FAFSA to have Pell Grant and Stafford loan eligibility determined.

State Assistance

To be considered for the Michigan Competitive Scholarship, a FAFSA must be processed by March 1, 2013. Other criteria include having a qualifying ACT score and having financial need as determined by the State.
