

These scholarships are available to students completing high school in 2013 and planning to enroll full-time for the 2013-2014 school year. Deadline to apply is March 25, 2013.

#### C.O.O.R. ISD Initiative Scholarship

Applicants must reside in the C.O.O.R. school district. Criteria includes minimum of 3.25 GPA & composite ACT score of 24 or higher to considered. This scholarship provides full tuition and fees for full-time enrollment fall & winter of 1<sup>st</sup> academic year and is renewable for a second year.

## Gilbert I. Stewart Scholarship

Applicant must have a cumulative of 3.50 GPA. This scholarship is \$1500 for 1st academic year and requires full time enrollment. It is renewable for second year.

#### President's Scholarship

Applicant must have a cumulative 3.00 GPA. This scholarship is \$1000 for 1st academic year and requires full time enrollment. It is renewable for second year.

### Federal Financial Aid

#### State Assistance

Other criteria include having a qualifying ACT score and having financial need as determined by the State.
