## SAND LAKE WOMEN'S AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Sand Lake Women's Auxiliary awards scholarships to assist qualified Iosco County residents attending or planning to attend an institution of higher learning. Scholarships are paid directly to the student's account at the institution. All students having a 3.0 or higher GPA will be considered. The scholarship is dependent upon the student's current GPA, enrollment status and co-curricular as well as extra-curricular activities relating to their community. Financial need as well as the applicant's intended field of study will also be considered in the evaluation process.

All scholarships are subject to annual fund availability. Scholarships will range from a minimum of \$500.00.

#### Procedures

Please be advised that submitting this application is in no way a guarantee that a scholarship will be awarded.

To ensure that the Scholarship Selection Committee reviews your application, you must comply with the guidelines and requirements as written.

#### Requirements-

- 1. Scholarships are limited to use at an accredited degree-granting institution of higher learning.
- 2. Candidates applying for a scholarship will receive only one scholarship annually.
- 3. Evidence of enrollment in an institution of higher learning must be submitted.
- 4. Full-time and part-time studies are eligible for consideration.
- 5. Applicant must be a resident of Iosco County.
- 6. Applications must be resubmitted yearly, as well as all other requirements.
- 7. Members of the Scholarship Committee and their families are not eligible for these scholarships.
- 8. Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, or state of physical handicap.

### Application Process

- 1. Submit a completed application form.
- 2. Submit two essays, each 200 words in length. In the first essay, describe what distinguishes your need from others. In a second essay, state how you will use your skills gained through your education.
- 3. Scholarship applications are accepted from January 1<sup>st</sup> through April 1<sup>st</sup>. Recipients will be notified June 1st.
- 4. A transcript from the previous year or last year of educational experience must be submitted with the application.
- 5. A resume' outlining educational background, work experience, co-curricular and extracurricular activities must be submitted with the application.
- 6. Submit three letters of reference (not relatives of the candidate) that address the suitability of the candidate for this scholarship, nature of the relationship with the applicant and the length of time of the relationship.
- 7. Applicants may be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
- 8. The Scholarship Committee shall be responsible for determining scholarship awards.
