

SUNRISE SIDE REPUBLICAN WOMEN'S ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

1. The applicant must be a female, U.S. citizen, a graduating senior from a high school in Iosco or Alcona County, who is a resident in Iosco or Alcona County.
2. The applicant must be accepted by a public or private postsecondary institution of higher education and have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

1. The scholarship will be for one year in length.
2. The amount of the scholarship will be \$1000.00
3. Applicants must participate in activities of the Sunrise Side Republican Women or Iosco or Alcona County Republican Party (preferred), and/or e.g.: attend meetings of governmental agencies (school board, township board, county board of commissioners); correspond with state and/or federal elected official(s) regarding an issue of concern to you. Please provide documentation of meeting this requirement.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Applications and statements must be typewritten and signed in all instances.
2. Official high school (and any college) transcripts are required from the beginning of the 9th grade and up through the last marking period prior to the application due date. Transcripts may be photocopied, provided the school authorizes it.
3. College admissions test scores are required to be attached and also may be photocopied.
4. The application should be prepared and arranged in the following order:
 - a. Application – be sure to number; 1 for freshmen year, and 2, 3 or 4 for subsequent years.
 - b. Write brief essay on what the Republican Principles mean to you (500 words or less).
 - c. College admission test scores.
 - d. Transcripts.
 - e. Two letters of recommendation from other than family members.
5. ***Deadline for submitting the application is the last Friday in March.*** Mail (preferred) or deliver to Sunrise Side Republican Women, c/o Sandra Hollabaugh, 4928 E. Cedar Lake Drive, Greenbush MI 48738, (989) 739-4722.
